

For the first time, SIVAL is hosting a Hackathon dedicated to artificial intelligence applied to plant production industries. In partnership with the Chamber of Agriculture of Pays de la Loire, this event invites multidisciplinary teams to design practical solutions to real-world challenges in just 48 hours.

The Concept

A hackathon is a fast-paced, intensive format designed to turn ideas into action. Over two days, developers, engineers, students, and agricultural experts will collaborate to create Al-driven solutions. Projects will be based on real challenges submitted by companies in the plant production sector.

Objective

To prototype AI tools in 48 hours that optimize agriculture — from input management and automation to decision support and data enhancement.
